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OUR CURRICULUM

(IGCSE) International General Certificate of Secondary Education

BISC-SL students in Grades 9 and 10 (Years 10 and 11) pursue the IGCSE, a rigorous curriculum that provides a strong foundation in core subjects. It emphasizes understanding and application of knowledge over rote memorization, fostering deeper learning and a better grasp of subjects.

Our students develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and independent research skills while choosing from a wide range of subjects, enabling them to tailor their education to their interests and career aspirations.

The IGCSE also encourages participation in extracurricular activities, promoting a well-rounded education that develops social, leadership, and teamwork skills. These advantages make the IGCSE an excellent choice for students seeking a strong academic background with international opportunities.

Course options:

Compulsory Courses: Math, English, Biology, Chemistry, U.S. History, Physical Education, Entrepreneurship for Social Impact

Course Routes:

Based on their Year 10-11 performance, students in Years 12 & 13 follow one of the following IB course routes:

1.) **IB Diploma Programme** Students study six IB courses, three must be at Higher Level (HL) honors and three at Standard Level (SL).

2.) **IB Career-related Programme** students study up to 3 IB-courses at Standard Level (SL) or Higher Level (HL) alongside a Career-related study.

IB Diploma Programme (IBDP)

Grades: 11 and 12 (Years 12 and 13)

Focus: Broad and academically rigorous university preparation

IB Courses: Students study six IB courses

Higher Level (HL): Three courses must be taken at HL

Standard Level (SL): Three courses are taken at SL

Curriculum: Provides broad and deep academic knowledge across multiple subject areas

University Preparation: Designed to prepare students for a wide range of university environments and rigorous higher education

International Mindedness: Develops international mindedness and intercultural understanding

Core Requirements: Extended Essay; Theory of Knowledge; Creativity, Activity & Service (CAS)

Learning Approach: Emphasizes academic depth, breadth, critical thinking, and independent learning

Best suited for: Students seeking a broad, academically intensive IB pathway and university preparation

Outcome: Broad academic preparation for higher education and global opportunities



IB Career-related Programme (IBCP)

Grades: 11 and 12 (Years 12 and 13)

Focus: Academic study combined with practical, career-focused learning

IB Courses: Students study up to three IB courses

Higher Level (HL): Students may take courses at HL or SL

Standard Level (SL): Students may take courses at SL or HL

Curriculum: Combines academic study with specialized career-related learning

University Preparation: Prepares students for higher education while also providing practical preparation for employment and future careers

International Mindedness: Develops international mindedness and intercultural understanding

Core Requirements: Personal & Professional Skills; Community Engagement; Reflective Project; Language & Cultural Studies

Learning Approach: Connects academic learning with real-world applications and future career aspirations

Additional Opportunities: BTEC Advanced Subsidiary Diploma in Business; Arizona State University Dual Enrollment Program

Best suited for: Students with specific career interests who want to combine academic study with career-related learning

Outcome: Combination of academic qualifications, career-related experience, transferable skills, and preparation for higher education or employment
